


PRIVATE EVENTS AT TALIESIN WEST

Set in the foothills of the McDowell Mountains, Taliesin West is one of Frank Lloyd Wright's most personal creations. Wright's vision and legacy continue to thrive at this unique location.

A desert escape just minutes from the resorts of Scottsdale, Taliesin West is unlike any other location in the Valley of the Sun to host your event. Here your guests will have the opportunity to engage with Frank Lloyd Wright's vision and legacy at the only National Historic site in Scottsdale, and one of two UNESCO World Heritage sites in Arizona. Take a private tour of the property, enjoy a performance on an acoustically perfect stage while sipping a glass of wine, and wow your guests with a dinner overlooking the Valley at sunset. Soak up the history, innovation, and awe that can only be found at Taliesin West.

THE CABARET

INDOOR · SEATS 50 · STANDING 60

The Cabaret Theatre is the perfect space for you and your guests to experience the brilliance and delight of a Frank Lloyd Wright design. The unique slope and shape of the room allow for unimpeded views of the small stage below and carry sound perfectly through the space. Perfect for an intimate evening of dining at Wright-designed tables or a performance that offers an exceptional experience found nowhere else.





GARDEN SQUARES

OUTDOOR · SEATS 250 · STANDING 350

With views of the Music Pavilion, Wright's Studio, and the McDowell Mountains, the Garden Squares are the perfect venue for groups large or small. This space can be adapted to fit your group's needs, while your guests are fully immersed in the wonder of Wright's work and the beauty of the desert.





THE KIVA

INDOOR · SEATS 13 · STANDING 20

The Kiva is a hidden treasure at Taliesin West. Named after an underground chamber used by Pueblo Indians, the Kiva was one of the first structures built on the property. Once used as a dining room, film screening room, lounge, and library, there is no limit to the uses of this space for intimate gatherings. Perfect for meetings or an exclusive dinner, the Kiva is the most private space on the property.





THE MUSIC PAVILION & PAVILION TERRACE

INDOOR/OUTDOOR · SEATS 108 · SEATED DINNER 80 · STANDING 175

A blend of Wright's passions for the arts and bringing the outside in, the Pavilion is a multi-functional hall that can be used for exhibitions, performances, dining, and more. The theatre's interior includes a series of curtained backdrops that can be arranged to change the depth of the stage, and a uniquely crafted roof that illuminates the room, day or night. Connected to the Pavilion is an outside Terrace filled with the many sculptural masterpieces by Wright's former apprentice, Heloise Crista. The Terrace is a stunning place to watch the sunset.





THE PROW, SUNKEN GARDEN, & SUNSET TERRACE

OUTDOOR · SEATS 200 · STANDING 250

The Prow is a beautiful terrace overlooking Scottsdale and Camelback Mountain, with amazing sunset views Wright referred to as "standing on the rim of the world." With three distinct adjoining areas creating a natural flow, your guests will feel at ease as they absorb the full beauty of the Sonoran Desert, while sipping on a drink and marveling at the sky full of stars.



EVENT PLANNING

Our Event Staff will work on behalf of Taliesin West to coordinate your event on property. We will work with you to tour the spaces, create a custom proposal and contract for your event, coordinate timing with your Venue Rental/Vendors, and provide necessary staff on site during your event. We will provide you with a list of our Approved Vendors, with whom you will contract to create menus, rent tables and chairs, as well as any other services your event requires.

External customer marketing and/or sales events
Any activity or event which may result in damage
or disturbance to Taliesin West's staff, property,
residents, the school, or other public use of
the property

VISIT THE VENUES

Taliesin West invites you to schedule an exclusive tour of the event spaces during regular business hours. Our Event Staff will escort you through the property, sharing stories about the spaces to show you what Taliesin West has to offer your group. Site tours must be scheduled at least 48 hours in advance with Event Staff.

BOOKING YOUR EVENT

Dates fill up quickly. A complimentary 14-day hold may be placed on any available date and venue once a contract has been sent by Foundation. After the 14-day hold, your date and venue are not guaranteed without a signed contract and deposit.

EXCLUSIVITY

The event venue that you rent is private to your group, while other simultaneous events or public tours may occur at Taliesin West.

To provide your group with exclusivity to all of Taliesin West event spaces, a buy-out of the property is required. While guests are not allowed to access areas of the property other than those they have rented, they may see other spaces with a tour guide. Tour information can be found under "Additional Amenities."

Please note Taliesin West is a living site the residents, students, and wildlife call home.

PRICING

Once we have all your event specifics, Foundation Event Staff will customize an event proposal with pricing specific to your group and event(s). Charitable nonprofit organizations may qualify for up to a 25% discount on pricing.

DEPOSIT & PAYMENT

A deposit of one half (50%) of the total contracted amount is due with submission of your signed contract. The remaining one half (50%) of the total contracted amount is due 30 days prior to the event. You may pay via credit card or check. All checks should be made payable to the Frank Lloyd Wright Foundation. Event venue is not guaranteed until your signed contract and deposit are received. All credit card payments will be subject to a 3.12% Service Charge.

ADDITIONAL AMENITY OPTIONS

Docent Led Tours: Tour Guides are experts on the goals and history of Wright's life and legacy and their explanations are enlightening as well as entertaining. Tour Guides will lead your guests to 3-5 preselected spaces around your event venue and treat them to an intimate tour. Tours range from 60-90 minutes during the day, 45-90 minutes at night. Daytime tours are limited to availability.

MINIMUM GUARANTEES

Client cash bars are subject to minimum guarantees, based on the Beverage Package chosen. Client's credit card will be held on file and remainder of minimum beverage payment will be processed following the event.

ALL TALIESIN WEST BEVERAGE SERVICES REQUIRE THE FOLLOWING

- 50-guest minimum guarantee; additional guests will be charged at the selected package price in increments of 25 quests
- \$150 Bartender Package (professional bartender, bar and bar supplies including plastic cups, cocktail napkins, and straws)
- 20% service charge and 3.12% merchant fee
- 5-hour beverage service maximum; additional hours are billed at \$10/hour per guest
- Should a renter choose to do a full bar through an approved caterer or bartender, they must pay a \$250 suspension fee and complete the necessary paperwork


