A National Historic Landmark and UNESCO World Heritage Site situated at the brow of the McDowell Mountains, Taliesin West is Frank Lloyd Wright's former residence, studio, and architectural school. With a career that spanned almost 70 years, Wright is one of the most influential architects of the twentieth century. Known for such iconic buildings as Fallingwater and the Guggenheim Museum, Wright developed Taliesin West in 1937, and it remained his winter residence until his death in 1959.

Currently home of the Frank Lloyd Wright Foundation, Taliesin West is also the perfect setting for your private event, photoshoot, brand experience, or corporate retreat. For Wright, the desert was "the greatest form of construction," and his designs exist harmoniously with the natural environment. The near seamless blending of indoor and outdoor spaces sets Taliesin West apart, creating a truly immersive and memorable experience for guests.

THE PROW & SUNSET TERRACE

OUTDOOR | SEATED 200 | STANDING 250

The Prow is an outdoor space overlooking Camelback Mountain and Scottsdale's cityscape. With three distinct adjoining areas creating a natural flow, your guests will feel relaxed and in awe, taking in the sunset and the surrounding Sonoran Desert. Standing on this beautiful terrace Frank Lloyd Wright once compared to "the rim of the world" with its amazing sunset views, we are sure you will agree.

THE MUSIC PAVILION & PAVILION TERRACE

INDOOR/OUTDOOR | TIERED THEATRE SEATING 108
SEATED ON STAGE 100 | STANDING ON STAGE 125

A multi-functional space, the Music Pavilion is a versatile venue that optimizes privacy for your guests. Dramatic and vibrant, the space is known for its perfect acoustics. Featuring a series of curtained backdrops that can be arranged to change the depth of the stage, the Pavilion is a favorite choice for performances, lectures, dining, and more. Outside its double doors is an intimate gathering space partially encircled by foliage and punctuated by the stunning sculptures of Wright apprentice, Heloise Crista. Often the perfect spot for a bar, registration table, or musicians, the Pavilion Terrace is a lovely space to enjoy the outdoor ambiance of Arizona.

GARDEN SQUARES

OUTDOOR | SEATED 300 | STANDING 350

With the McDowell Mountains in view and surrounded by Wright's distinctive, historic architecture, the Garden Squares are truly an immersion into Taliesin West. A blank canvas that can be tailored to any event experience you envision; the Garden Squares are ideal for groups both large and small. While this space has our largest capacity, the versatility of the Garden Squares means it will beautifully accommodate a sit down dinner for hundreds of guests as easily as it can be reimagined for more intimate gatherings.

THE PERGOLA

OUTDOOR | SEATED 100 | STANDING 100

Transformed from being a central passage through the heart of Taliesin West's historic core into an event venue, this intimate space abuts the Drafting Room on one side and a hedge of vivid, verdant bougainvillea on the other, with the wide-open Garden Squares just beyond it. Semi-sheltered by the beams above, the Pergola is a versatile space, easily reimagined with long family-style tables for sit-down dinners or set up with bars and high-tops to create an inviting lounge atmosphere.

THE CABARET

INDOOR | TIERED THEATRE SEATING 40
SEATED FOR DINNER 42 | STANDING 50

The charm of the Cabaret Theatre is unmistakable: its low ceiling and desert masonry walls create an intentional intimacy in signature Wright fashion. Here, guests can enjoy presentations and performances while dining comfortably at the upholstered seating and drop-leaf tables Wright designed over 75 years ago. The space’s subtle slope and shape allow for unimpeded views of the stage as well as optimal acoustics.

THE KIVA

INDOOR | TABLE SEATING 13 | STANDING 20

The Kiva is a hidden treasure at Taliesin West. Named after an underground chamber used by the pueblo indigenous peoples, the Kiva was one of the first structures built on the property. Once used as a dining room, film screening theater, lounge, and library, there is no limit to the uses of this space for intimate gatherings. Perfect for meetings or a small dinner, the Kiva is the most private space on our historic property.

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

EVENT PLANNING

The In-house Events Team at Taliesin West will assist in coordinating the venue rental, selection of vendor providers, and logistics for guest arrival, reception, dinner, and tours of the historic property. On the day of your event, members of the Event Team will assist in facilitating your event from load-in to load-out.

VISIT THE VENUES

Taliesin West invites you to schedule an exclusive tour of the event spaces during regular business hours. Our Event Staff will escort you through the property, sharing insights about the spaces to show you what Taliesin West has to offer your group.

ENHANCE YOUR EVENT

Enhance your guests' experience with a tour! Add our docent-staffed ASK-ME STATIONS to your cocktail hour or reception, allowing guests to explore selected rooms at their leisure. Docents will be stationed throughout the Historic Core to share insights into Taliesin West's rich history.

The Docent Ask Me This experience is available for \$500 (gratis with a site buyout).

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

EXCLUSIVITY

Your event venue is private to your group, though other events or public tours may occur simultaneously at Taliesin West.

For exclusive use of all event spaces, a property Buyout is required. While guests are not allowed to access areas of the property other than those specific to the event, they may see other spaces with the Docent Ask-Me experience.

Please note Taliesin West is home to year-round residents and Foundation guests.

Dates fill up quickly! We are happy to place a courtesy hold on a date and space, however, your booking is only secured with a signed contract and deposit.

EVENTS NOT PERMITTED

- Personal social events such as wedding receptions, bridal showers, birthday parties, rehearsal dinners, baby showers, bar/bat mitzvahs, family reunions, anniversary parties, retirement parties, celebrations of life, or memorial services
- External customer marketing and/or sales events
- Religious or political
- Any activity or event which may result in damage or disturbance to Taliesin West's staff, property, residents, or other public use of the property



PRICING AND PAYMENT

EVENT PLANNING

Every space rental at Taliesin West includes on-site venue coordination provided by our skilled Event and Hospitality Staff as part of the fee. Your guests will also benefit from complimentary parking at the venue.

IMPORTANT: Because Taliesin West is open to the public nearly every day of the year for tours of our historic site, only the Music Pavilion and Music Pavilion Terrace are available for daytime events, in addition to evening functions.

- All other venues can be rented exclusively for evening events and programs.
- We kindly request that events start at 6:00 p.m. and conclude by 10:00 p.m.
 - Please note that we do not host events from June through August due to seasonal considerations.

DEPOSIT & PAYMENT

A deposit of 50% is due with submission of your signed contract. The remaining 50% of the total contracted amount is due 30 days prior to the event. You may pay via credit card, wire transfer, or check. All checks should be made payable to the Frank Lloyd Wright Foundation.

An event venue is not guaranteed until your signed contract and deposit are received.
